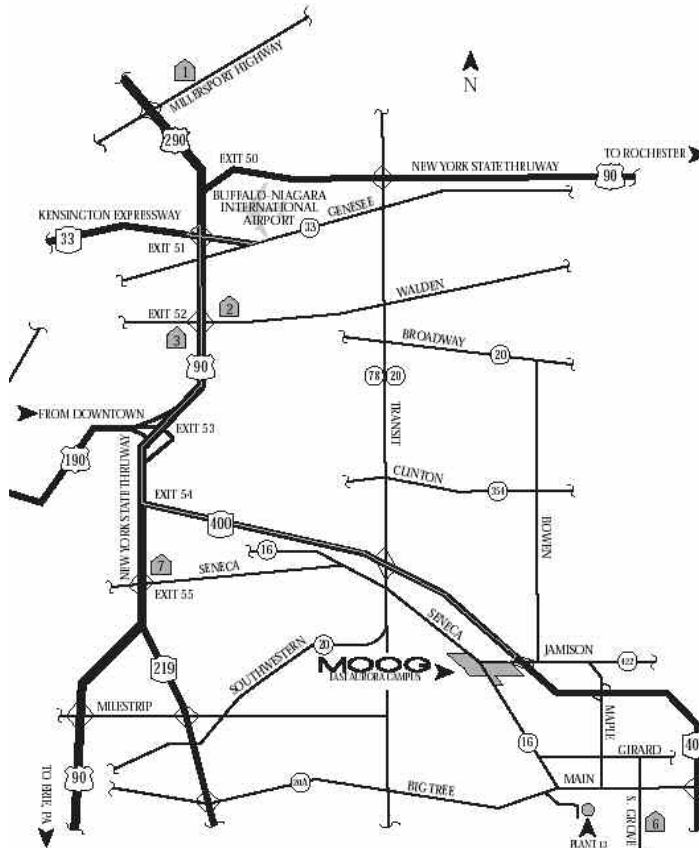
FROM THE GREATER BUFFALO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT:

- Access to the New York State Thruway is gained by exiting the Airport and following the signs onto Route 33A / Kensington Expressway. Stay in the right lane; take Route 33 approximately 2 miles and exit onto the I-90 West/Erie (second I-90 exit)
- Proceed West on the Thruway to Exit 54- East Aurora Expressway/Route 400 (approx. 8 miles). Take Route 400 approximately 8 miles to the Jamison Rd. exit.

FROM THE NEW YORK STATE THRUWAY EAST or WEST:

At exit 54 of the Thruway, take the East Aurora Extension (Route 400) approximately 8 miles to its Jamison Rd. exit.

- Turn right on Jamison Rd. the **Space and Defense Group** facility of Moog (S&D Group and **Information Technology**) is the first left.
- Continuing on Jamison Rd. the entrances to the **Industrial Controls Division, Purchasing, and Aircraft Group** will follow.
- At the corner of Jamison Rd. and Seneca St., turn left and another entrance to the **Aircraft Group** will be on your left.
- At the corner of Jamison Rd. and Seneca St., turn left and the entrance to the **Human Resource Development Center** will be on your right.
- For **Corporate Offices** turn right at Seneca, go 400 yards, and the entrance is on your left.

FROM DOWNTOWN BUFFALO:

- Access to the Thruway is best gained by means of its Niagara extension, Route I -190 South.
 - Access to Route I -190 South is available off the downtown streets Oak, Church and Niagara.
 - Upon reaching the Thruway (Route 90) proceed west to exit 54.

FROM BATAVIA and other points East, Using Route 98

- Starting at Rte. 33 & Rte. 98 in Batavia, NY 98/Walnut St. becomes NY 98.
 - Turn right onto ramp.
 - Merge onto US 20 approx. 11 miles.
 - US 20 becomes US 20/Broadway St.
 - Approx. 3 miles, turn left onto Two Rod Rd.
 - Approx. 3 miles, turn right onto NY 354/Clinton St.
 - Take Clinton St. to Girdle Rd., turn left.
 - Turn right onto Bullis Rd.
 - Turn left onto Bowen Rd.
 - Turn right onto Jamison Rd.
 - Moog campus begins just past the 400 Expressway on and off ramps.

FROM OLEAN and other points South Using Route 16

- Start on Rte. 16 in Olean heading North
- Approximately 45 miles in South Wales, Route 16 becomes the 400 Expressway.
- Take the Rte. 400 Expressway to the Jamison Road exit.
- At Jamison Road turn left.
- Our plants line Jamison Rd., which ends at Seneca St.

Using Route 219

- Start by heading Southwest on Rte. 16
- Take the Rte. 17 Southern Tier Expressway ramp.
- Merge onto NY 17 W.
- Take the US 219 N/Parkway Dr. exit – exit number 21 – towards Salamanca.
- Merge onto US 219.
- Go approx. 50 miles to the Rt. 179 E/Milestrip Rd. exit.
- Turn left onto Southwestern Blvd.
- Go straight approx. 4 miles to Transit Rd.
- Turn right at Transit Rd. (which is Rte. 16).
- Moog Corporate Headquarters is approx. 5 miles down on the right hand side.
- For other Moog Buildings, approx. 1/8 mile past Corporate Headquarters, turn left on Jamison Rd. Our campus occupies the area between Seneca St. and the 400 Expressway ramps.
